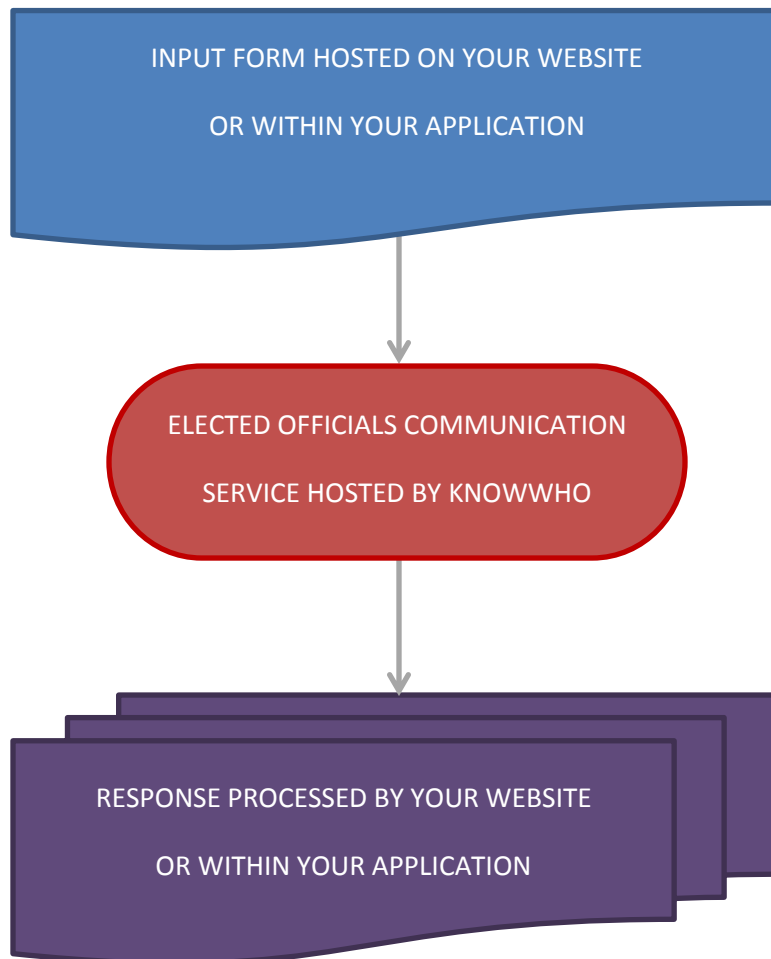




Elected Officials Communication Service (EOCS) How It Works

The KnowWho Elected Officials Communications Service (EOCS) was developed to facilitate electronic communication with elected officials through the most efficient method, including email and automatic web form submission. The EOCS accepts and returns strings of XML and JSON, with the input containing standardized values required for electronic message processing and the output containing a summary of the results of the submission(s).

The service is utilized through a subscription and the purchase of credits. Specific usage determines the decrementing of credits, which cost less per unit as the number of credits purchased increase.



You issue a request from your website or application using JSON or XML, our EOCS processes message delivery to the selected recipients, and returns a confirmation response with the ID's of the elected officials to whom the message was sent. You can log the returned officials to relate to our other web services or data services, or simply acknowledge the successful delivery of the message.

The hallmark of our web services is flexibility since you have complete control over how you process and display the information returned by our service. No limitations mean maximum control in your design.
